

White Card Evidence of Identity Requirements - Verification

Evidence of identity documents must be supplied before a White Card can be issued and must be made up of three matching **original** documents. The three original documents (must be sited) can be made up of:

- One from Category A & two from Category B; or
- Two from Category A & one from Category B

NOTE: At least one Category A document must be photographic and show a full name and date of birth. Indicate the document supplied and record document details (ie- Document Number, Expiry Date).
